Operations review

More than 1 in 4 (26.7%) kids in working households in the North East are now growing up in poverty.*

Darlington, Bishop Auckland, Middlesbrough and Hartlepool are amongst the constituencies with the highest child poverty levels in the North East**

We estimate that some **1.1 million adults – or 2.1% in the UK are unbanked.** The proportion of 18-24 year old's unbanked is more than double that of those aged 25 and over.***

People across Britain faced a **"triple savings challenge"** of insufficient savings, an inability to cope financially with major life events such as family breakdown, and inadequate retirement incomes.

11.2 million people lived in households that had savings of less than £1,000, accounting for about one in three working-age households. ****

Financial inclusion - how we are helping

- Savings we seek to encourage everyone, irrespective of their circumstances to save. Our Christmas savings account helped 115 members save an average of £270 taking the pressure off one of the most expensive times of the year.
- Loans we issued 1359 loans totalling £1,141,806 with a maximum APR of 42.6%. Many of the loans are of low value and to members with poor credit files whose only alternative would be to borrow from high cost lenders or even loan sharks.
- Education through our MoneySmart project funded by the National Lottery Community Fund we have supported more than 500 people to better understand their finances and take control of their bills.






Savings by age group




